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Welcome to our Insight Report

During March-May 2020 CILT International engaged with its 90+ training and education partners across the world to understand the impact of the COVID-19 situation on learning and development activities.

Over 65% of our partners came back to use with comprehensive comments and customer insight. We received 49 detailed feedback pro formas covering 28 countries where we provide training capability and CILT accredited courses.

The findings have enabled us to adapt our global education approach and support mechanisms but also helped us understand the 'local' response and the resilience of the training sector in different countries and cultures. These findings are a snapshot insight, but they also help us to plan for the future.




♥ Countries with training providers that replied to our Covid-19 impact survey



Institute of Logistics Types of course running at March 2020 and Transport


Which CILT education and training programmes are you currently running?





Understanding COVID-19 impacts


With the impact of the coronavirus (COVID -19) what are your immediate/short-term plans?





Moving to virtual learning formats


If you have to operate as a virtual learning centre, what type of support would be helpful to you?

Market Impact findings

This question focused on market impact targeted short to medium term impacts due to the coronavirus outbreak. The headline market impact messages covered these themes:

- Strong support for online leaning and development of products
- A key need to update reduce materials and the course content including the introduction of additional modules and units
- Smart use of pre-recoded content
- The need to reduce the amount of contact time and encourage learning through a diversified range of media
- Recognition of prior learning and skills
- Moving to a more flexible blended assessment model
- Online platform help and support
- Flexibility to applying financial adjustments around membership and course fees
- Media exposure and market presence including clear career pathways



Institute of Logistics Key suggestions from training partners

The 'open question' on future measures that could be taken gave strong consistent messages about:

- Development of marketing packs and guidance
- Support with online and market diversification advice
- Tackling lower levels of conventional enrolment with on line to compensate
- Key income impacts for training providers compounded by business clients cutting back on training and skilling
- Easier access to materials and resources including digitalisation
- Development of the CILT Knowledge Centre hub as a wider e-library service offering including access to e-study resources and ebooks
- The need to facilitate best practice sharing between providers
- Addition train the trainer resources to support virtual leaning



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
