## Welcome to Country\*



In Australia we recognise the unique position of Aboriginal people in Australian culture and history and show respect for Aboriginal people. Traditionally, a Welcome to Country was an invitation or permission for a person from a different area to pass through or enter. Doing so without it was unacceptable.

Incorporating a Welcome or Acknowledgement protocol into official meetings and events shows that you recognise Aboriginal people as the First Australians and custodians of their land. It demonstrates that you, or your organisation, are aware of the past and ongoing connection of Aboriginal people to place and land.

An 'Acknowledgement of Country' is a way where CILT Australia can show awareness and respect for Aboriginal culture and heritage and the ongoing relationship the traditional custodians have with their land.
