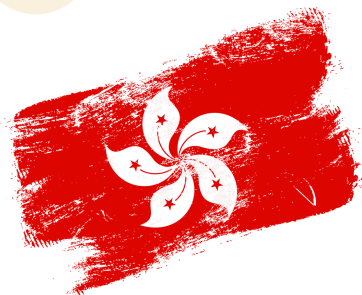

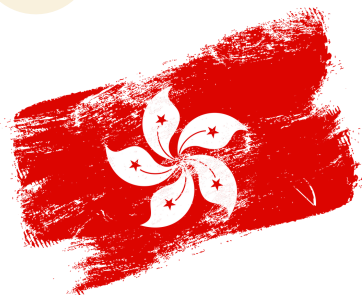

ELEVATE 2026

ELEVATE 2026 is a structured global leadership programme for professionals in transport, logistics, and supply chain management.

The programme combines:

- 11 expert-led online masterclasses (12 June – 21 August 2026, 9–11AM GMT)
- Optional Hong Kong technical visits (17–20 September 2026)
- Optional attendance at the CILT International Conference (21–24 September 2026)

Participants may choose full online participation or extend their learning through curated international industry immersion in Hong Kong.

Terms & Conditions

1. Registration & Payment

- Full payment is required to confirm participation.
- Registration closes on 15 May 2026 or earlier if seats are filled.
- Seats for technical visits and conference attendance are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

2. Programme Delivery

- Online sessions will be conducted live via designated digital platform.
- The organiser reserves the right to adjust session sequence, speakers, or timing if required.
- Technical visit itineraries are subject to confirmation by host organisations.

3. Technical Visits & Conference

- On-site visits are subject to operational approval by host facilities.
- Participants must comply with all safety, security, and confidentiality requirements of visit locations.
- Access may be denied by host organisations without prior notice if operational circumstances change.

4. Travel & Accommodation

- For Hong Kong components, double-sharing lodging is included where stated.
- Airfare, visa costs, travel insurance, airport transfers, and meals are not included unless expressly stated.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring valid travel documentation.

5. Cancellation & Refund Policy

- Cancellations made 30 days before programme commencement: 70% refundable.
- Cancellations made within 30 days: non-refundable.
- Substitutions are permitted with written notice.
- No refunds for partial attendance.

6. Force Majeure

- The organiser shall not be liable for programme changes due to circumstances beyond reasonable control, including travel restrictions, government regulations, or operational constraints of host sites.
- In such cases, reasonable alternatives will be arranged.
