# **Participation in CILT Programmes Internationally**

#### Africa Forum

CILT Ghana successfully participated in the 2016 CILT Africa Forum from March 4 – 6 in Mauritius. The President – Rev. G. D. Mensah represented the Institute and delivered a paper on "**Public and Private Sector Involvement in Freight Transport Management and Organisation**" at the forum.



#### **International Convention**

At the 2016 International Convention held in Montreal, Canada in May 8 – 11, 2016; the President – Mr. G. D. Mensah led the CILT Ghana's delegation made up of the Vice President for Education and Professional Development – Mr. Mark Amoamah and other senior members of the institute. The Executive Secretary – Mr. Ebo Hammond could not attend due to his inability to secure visa on time.

In all, a total of 4 delegates from Ghana were at the convention. Due to visa denial on the part of the Canadian Embassy in Ghana, members who were desirous to attend could not do so and it is our hope that more and more members would be granted visas to enable them attend next year's convention in Macao.



# AGM

CILT Ghana successfully had its Annual General Meeting (AGM) on April 28, 2016 with a Seminar in the morning under the theme *"Managing Critical Logistics for the Saving of Lives: The Case of Health Logistics"*. The seminar was designed for line managers, supervisors and middle level managers working in the field of logistics and transport, Procurement and Supply Officers/Managers, Health Service Administrators of health institutions, personnel in supply and transport departments in the armed forces, police, prisons; Electoral Officers and Examinations Officers and other Professionals.

The Institute also took the opportunity during the AGM to officially launch its **Fellows Guild** and this was performed by the Honorable Minister of Transport, Ghana. Upgraded / Newly Elected Members were also sworn into membership.

The Workshop was designed to provide world class standards, best practices and methods in corporate transport fleet management and a lot of practical hands-on activities with special delivery focus for both public and private fleet practitioners. A total of 251 participants benefited from the three events including 48 staff of Metro Mass Transit Ltd, Ghana. We were also privileged to have four (4)

# organizations coming onboard as sponsors.

- Two of CILT Ghana's newly accredited institutions (Ghana Technology University and Tamale Polytechnic) have fully started running the programme.
- There has been 22% increase in student enrolment from 285 to 349 between 2015 & 2016
- The CILT Professional programme visibility has increased across the country such that more tertiary institutions (three institutions) have applied for accreditation. They are Zenith University College, Ghana; Koforidua Technical University, Ghana and Institut Superieur des Langues et des Affaires (ISLA), Togo.
