

# **SUMMARY REPORT FOR CILT AFRICA REGION**

## **1. AFRICA FORUM 2020**

- CILT Ghana is expected is hosting the conference
- Host City- Accra
- Host Hotel- La Palm Royale (finalizing agreement)
- Date- 18-20, March 2020
- Expected Number of Delegates- 300 (including local members)
- Expected Number of Member Countries- 15
- International Delegates Registration Fees- Members-\$330; WiLAT-\$280; YPs-\$250;
- Non-member-\$350; Corporate member=\$500; Non-corporate member-\$600
- Vice President of Ghana is expected to officially open the conference
- IVP & Africa forum Chairman is expected to visit Ghana in mid-January 2021 to finalise the preparations.

## **2. AFRICA FORUM 2021**

- CILT Zambia is expected to host 2021 Africa Forum Conference
- IVP and Chairman is expected to travel to Zambia to reaffirm this position with the new CILT Zambia leadership structure before the end of this year (2019)
- International Secretariat to write a letter formally requesting then to host

## **3. CILT Tanzania**

- CILT Tanzania has been suspended over issues of corporate governance.
- The branch will be under the jurisdiction of the IVP for the period 2020 hoping to restructure and have it to retain its status in 2021 with new leadership
- Membership will be handled by CILT Zimbabwe during the care and maintenance period.
- A visit to Tanzania is expected early next year (2021)

## **4. NEW BRANCHES**

- CILT Rwanda- 2021
- CILT Mozambique- 2021
- CILT Malawi-2021
- Visits to these countries are planned for next year

## 5. IVP AFRICA BRANCH VISITS

- IVP Africa and Chairman of Africa Forum is expected to visit most African Branches in a single round trip as its cost effective with an effort to revive less active Branches, check issues of corporate governance and growth strategy
- The itinerary to be shared with Secretary General for funding approval purposes.
